**A. Student Council**

#### **D. Chair Report**

- Hua Lei has researched and found a new platform to improve the system for Council to send out emails. The cost is \$24 US per year and can send up to 400 emails at once. If we need to send more, a per-use charge will be implemented. This will be set up by Hua and a CHS Administrator, with the cost being put on the school credit card and council then reimbursing CHS.
- Registration Days to be held the last week of August and include the Grade 9 Orientation and BBQ, and the collection of the Arts fees. Hua to take over the Volunteer coordinator role for this event.
- The next Parent Council meeting has been moved to the third Tuesday in September (September 19) at 7pm to allow for information being given to parents at the mini timetable night. Elections will be held on this night. At the current time, meetings will then continue on the Second Tuesday of every month starting at 7pm, but can be changed in the future.
- Thursday September 14<sup>th</sup> is the mini timetable night. Grace Howland will be there early, set up in the Lobby with Chromebooks for parents to sign up electronically for Parent Council emails, and will be there after as well. Mr. Johnson and Mr. MacDonald will work together to have the Google form prepared for that night.

- Commencement will be held on June 30 at the Adult High School. Ellen Lamarre will be there to assist with handing out awards/certificates as needed, on behalf of Parent Council.

### **3. OCASC report**

- Liane Jelly mentioned that Representation for the Secondary Schools is struggling and no elections were held for the next year. They continue to look for more members. Meetings are held right after the OCASC meetings, monthly on Thursday evenings.
- Nadine may not continue as Community Representative next year but Liane will follow up with her this summer.
